To ease the application process and before completing and submitting this application, please carefully review the qualifying criteria for this scholarship as well as how it will be dispersed.

To qualify for this Scholarship, you must be:

- A graduating senior from one of the following Vermont schools: Burr and Burton Academy, Long Trail School or Home Schooled and residing in one of the BBA Sending Towns — Danby, Dorset, Dover, Landgrove, Londonderry, Manchester, Mt. Tabor, Peru, Stratton, Sunderland, Wardsboro, Weston, Winhall.
- A full-time legal resident of Vermont. **Sorry, International and Exchange Students are not eligible to apply.**
- Accepted and enrolled full time in an accredited 4-year college or university that is listed on the official website of the US Department of Education, for the following school year.

- Agronomy
- Agriculture Education
- Floriculture
- Horticulture
- Landscape Design
- Botany, Biology
- Forestry
- Wildlife Science
- Plant Pathology/Science
- City (Rural / Urban) Planning
- Habitat or Forest/Systems Ecology
- Environmental Concerns (Management: Environmental, Horticulture Resource/Environmental Behavior)
- Environmental Conservation (inc. Engineering, etc.)
- Land Management and/or other related or allied subjects.

**How & When will you receive the funds?**

- The scholarship recipient will be notified before the end of their high school senior year and will be asked to participate in a press release that will be distributed to the local media.
- The scholarship funds will be released directly to the awardee's college or university after submission of their college first semester transcript along with proof of the

following :

- Successful completion of their first full-time semester in the study of coursework that qualifies for the scholarship in the school in which they were enrolled.
- Full-time enrollment for their second semester in an above listed qualifying major.
